Many thanks for your attention. I am seeking projects involving the management, design, implementation, and deployment of software for scientific and biomedical applications.

I've been the principal software scientist at a leading laboratory of the National Institutes of Health (NIH) for 15 years, and in 2006 converted to contractor status in order to expand on commercial software development projects. The software I've developed at the NIH has become a standard part of the practice of nuclear magnetic resonance (NMR) proteomics across the world, and has been used to help generate roughly one-third of all NMR protein structures which have ever been measured, including 70% of the structures deposited in the Protein Data Bank over the last year. The journal publication describing the software enjoys over 3000 citations, and I've presented the software's application at invited lectures and courses in over a dozen countries.

In addition, I've served as a consultant for numerous pharmaceutical companies, and deployed several special-purpose software applications for drug discovery by NMR directly to leading commercial labs. Prior to joining the NIH, I was Manager of Software Development in an "Inc 500" top small company, and I've served as a consultant for scientific and biomedical software companies, analytical instrument manufacturers, and medical imaging companies.

I'm very hopeful you will agree that my skills can support your projects, and I look forward to discussing your plans in earnest.
